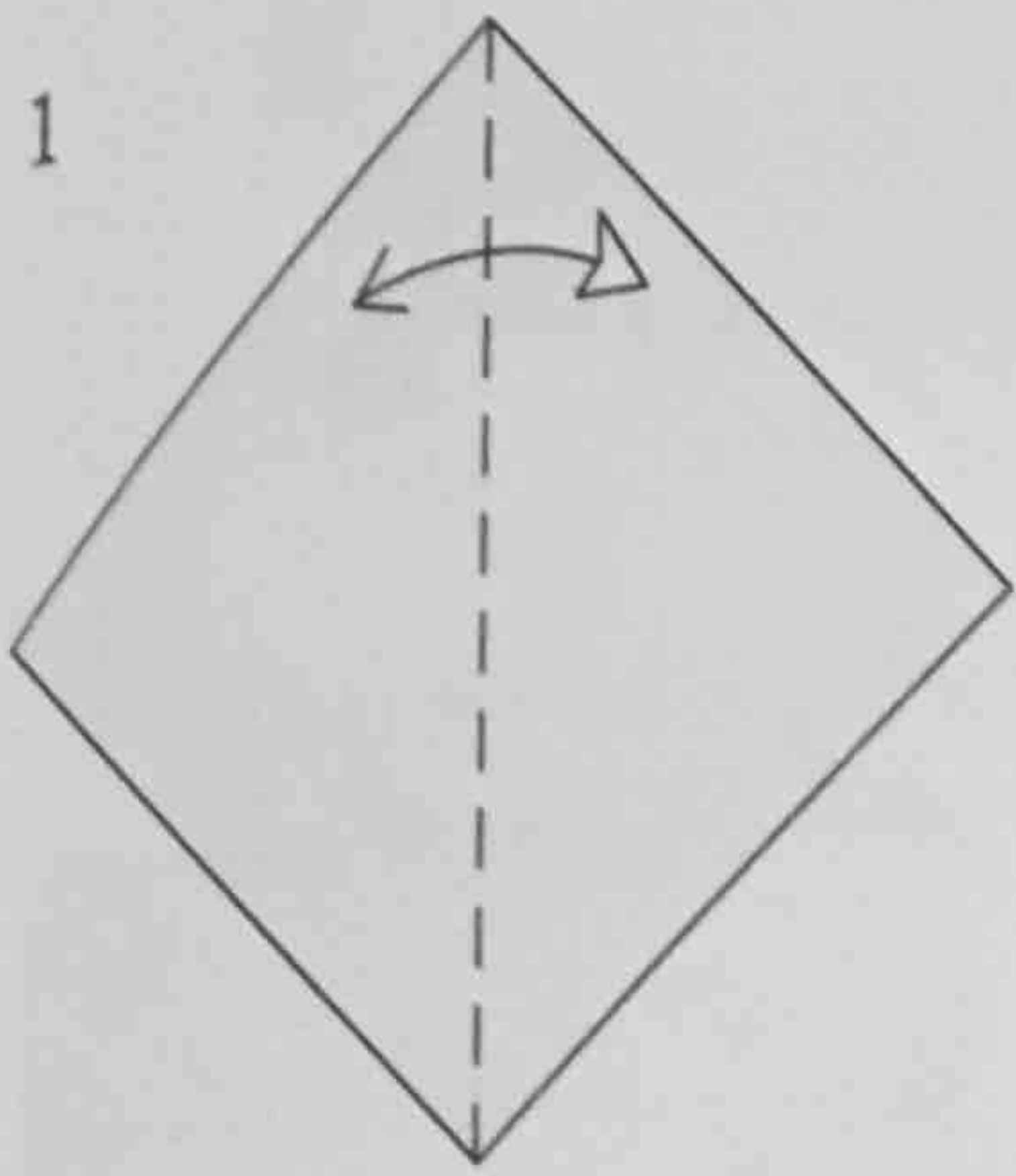
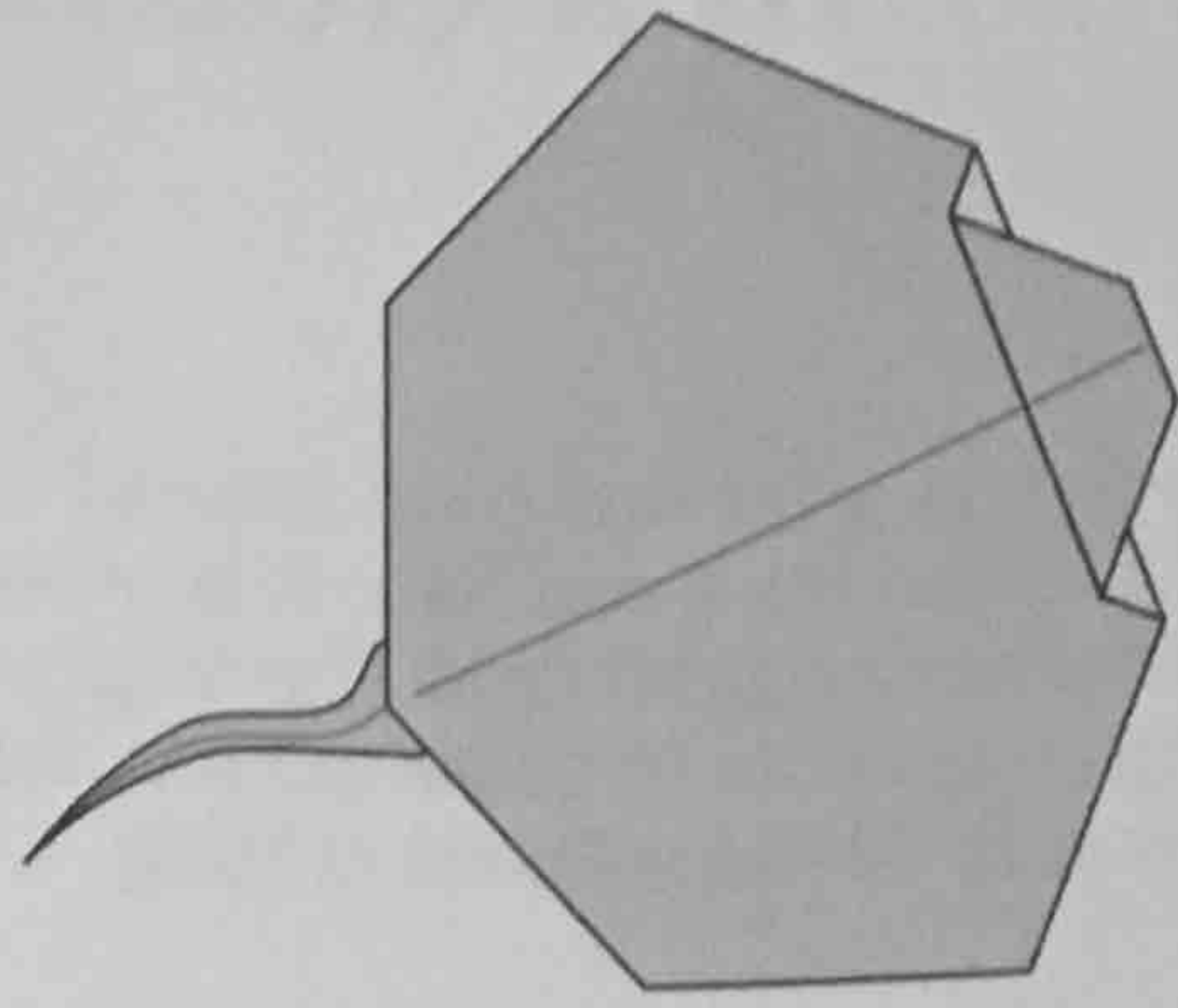
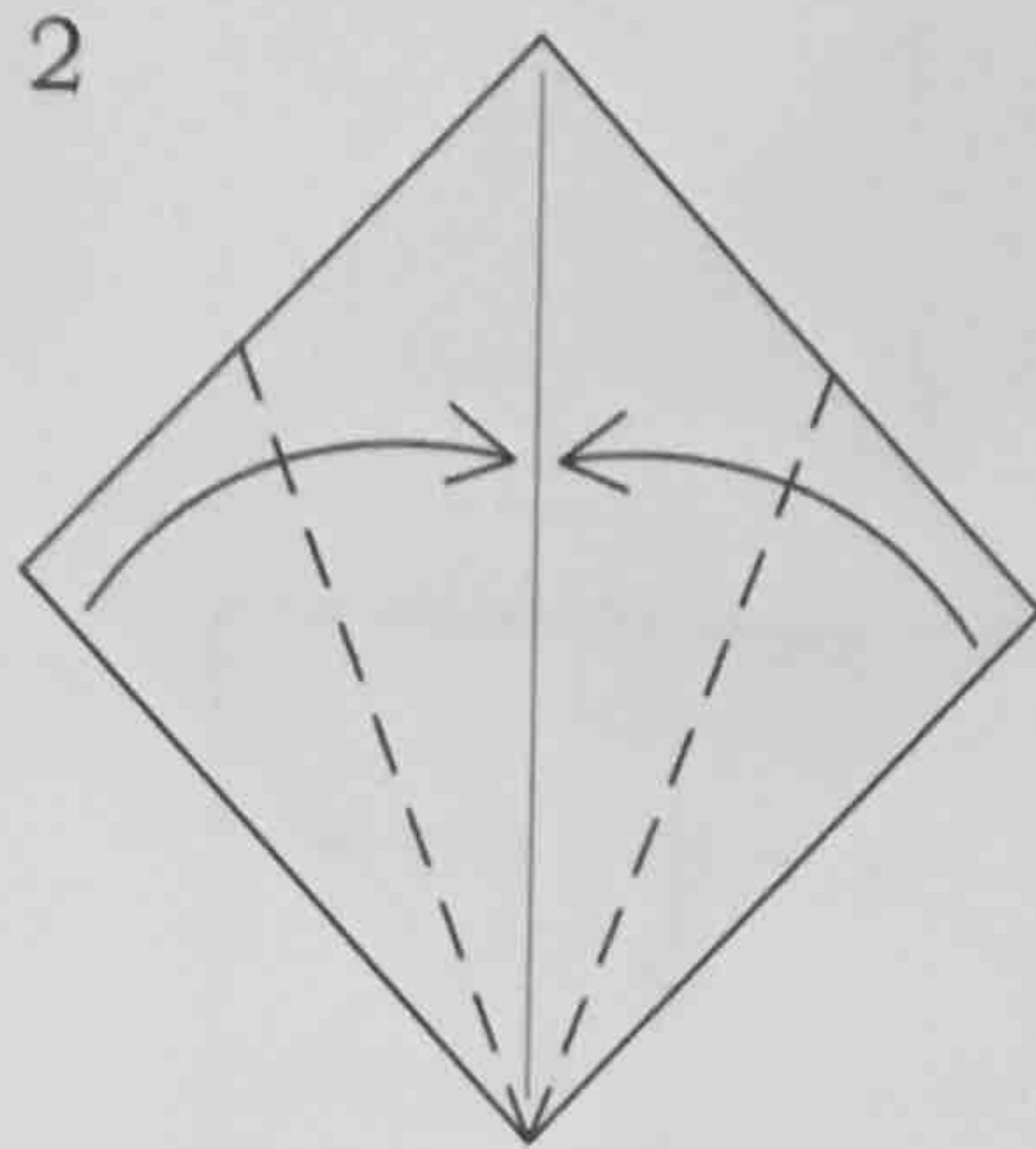


# Ray

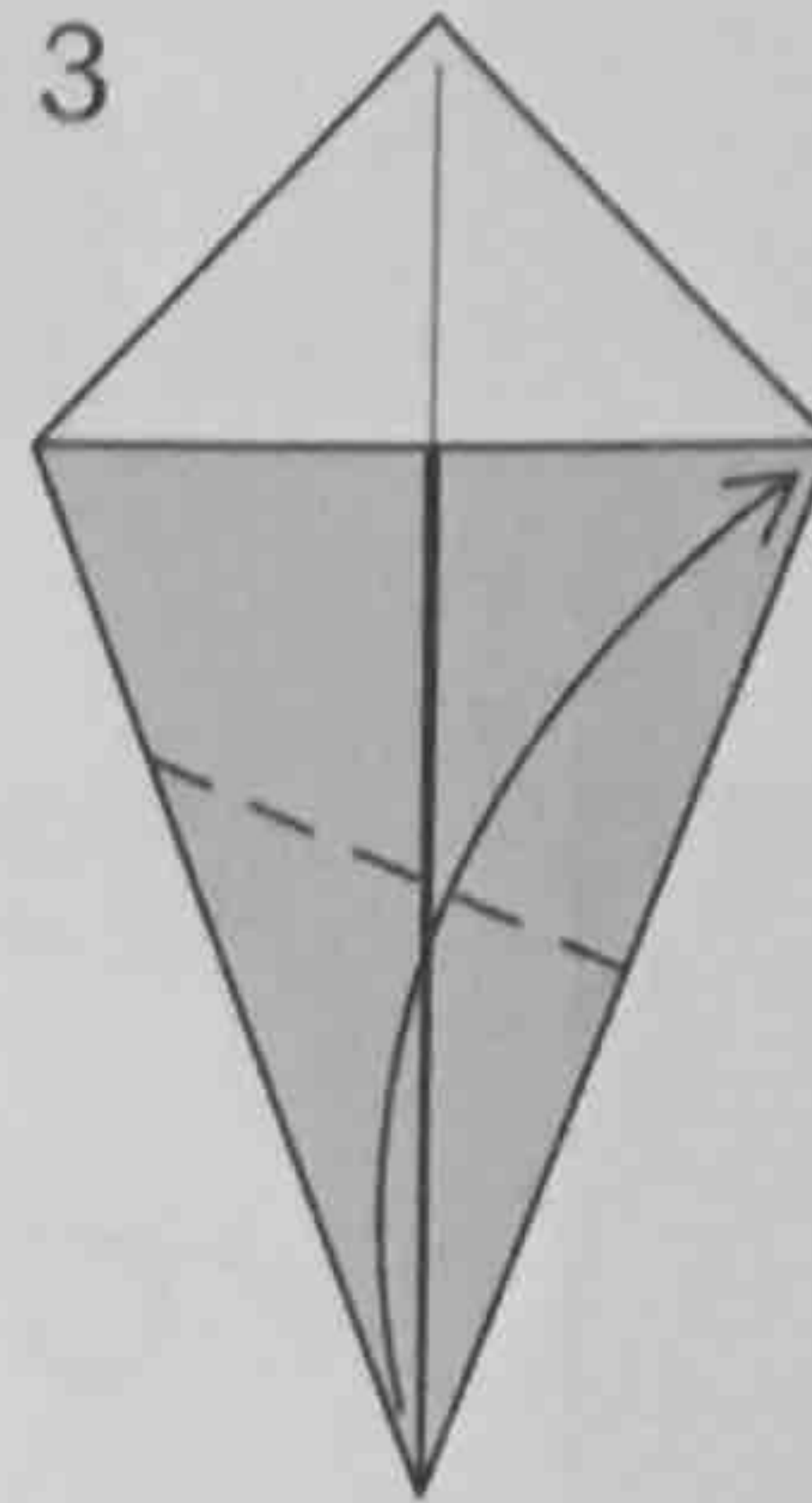
Skates and rays (order *Rajiformes*) are flat-bodied cartilaginous fish with wide pectoral fins that give their body the appearance of a flattened disk or polygon. Some species have venomous spines at the base of their tail.



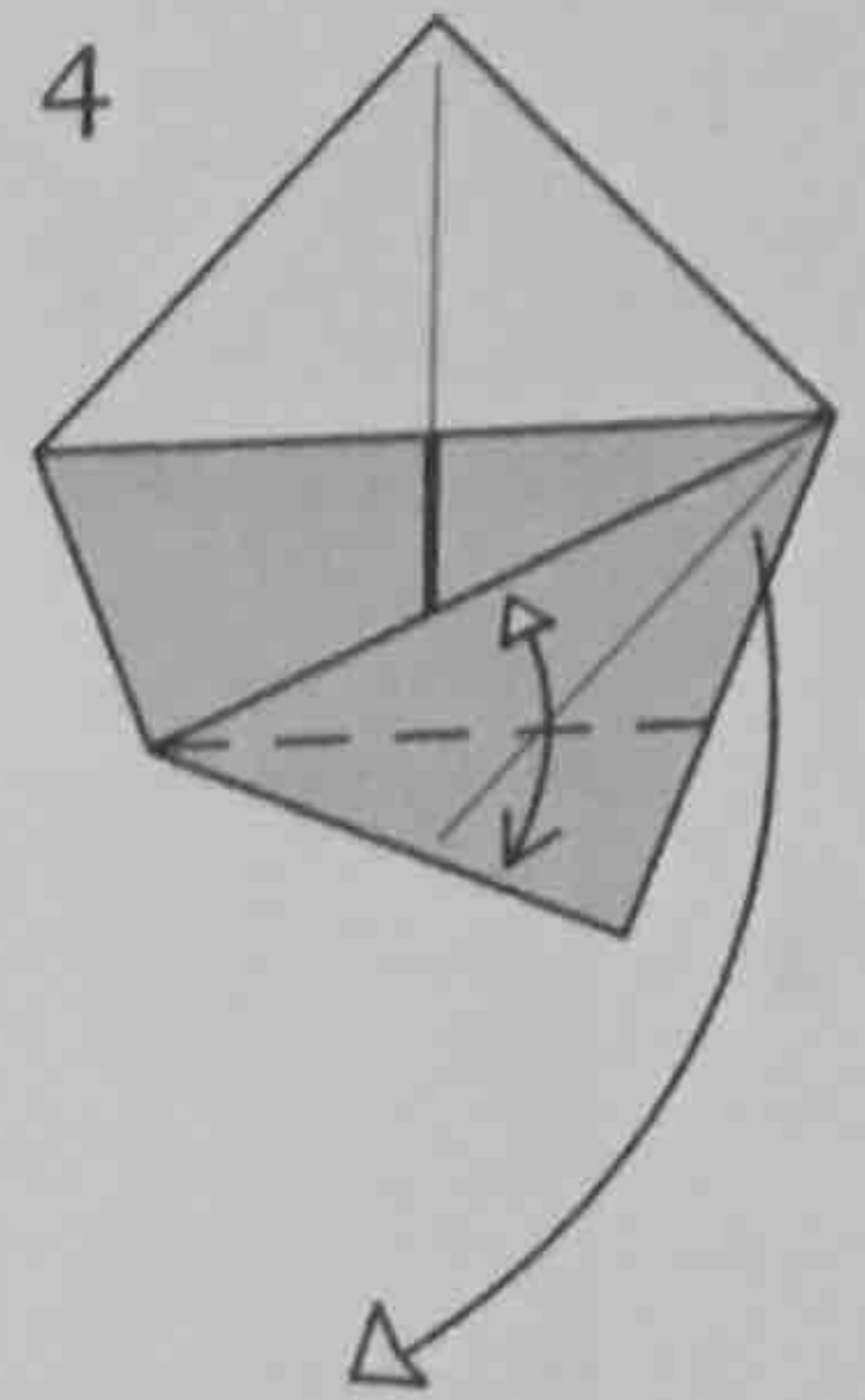

White side up. Fold and unfold along the diagonal.



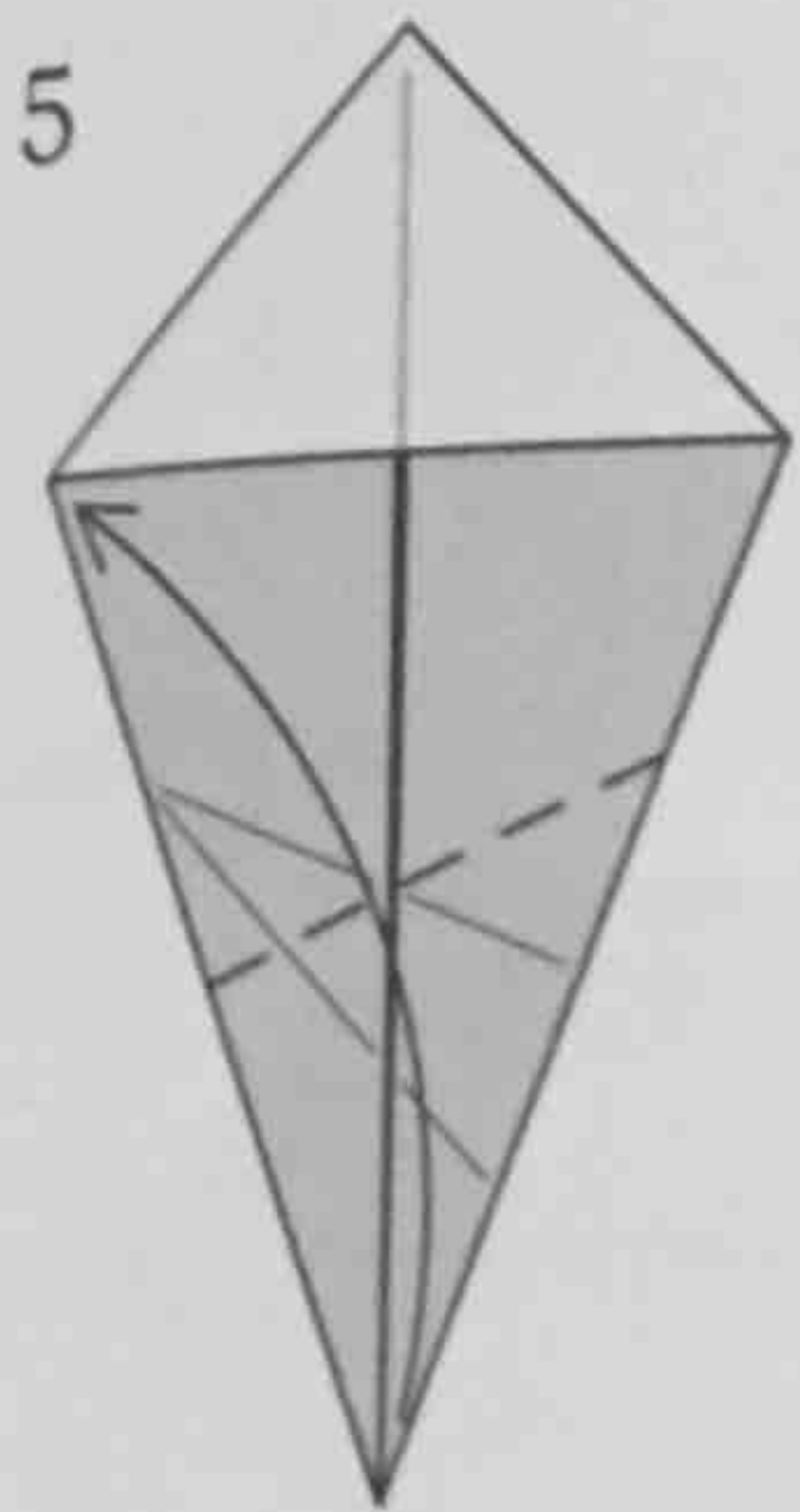

Fold the lower edges in to meet along the center line.



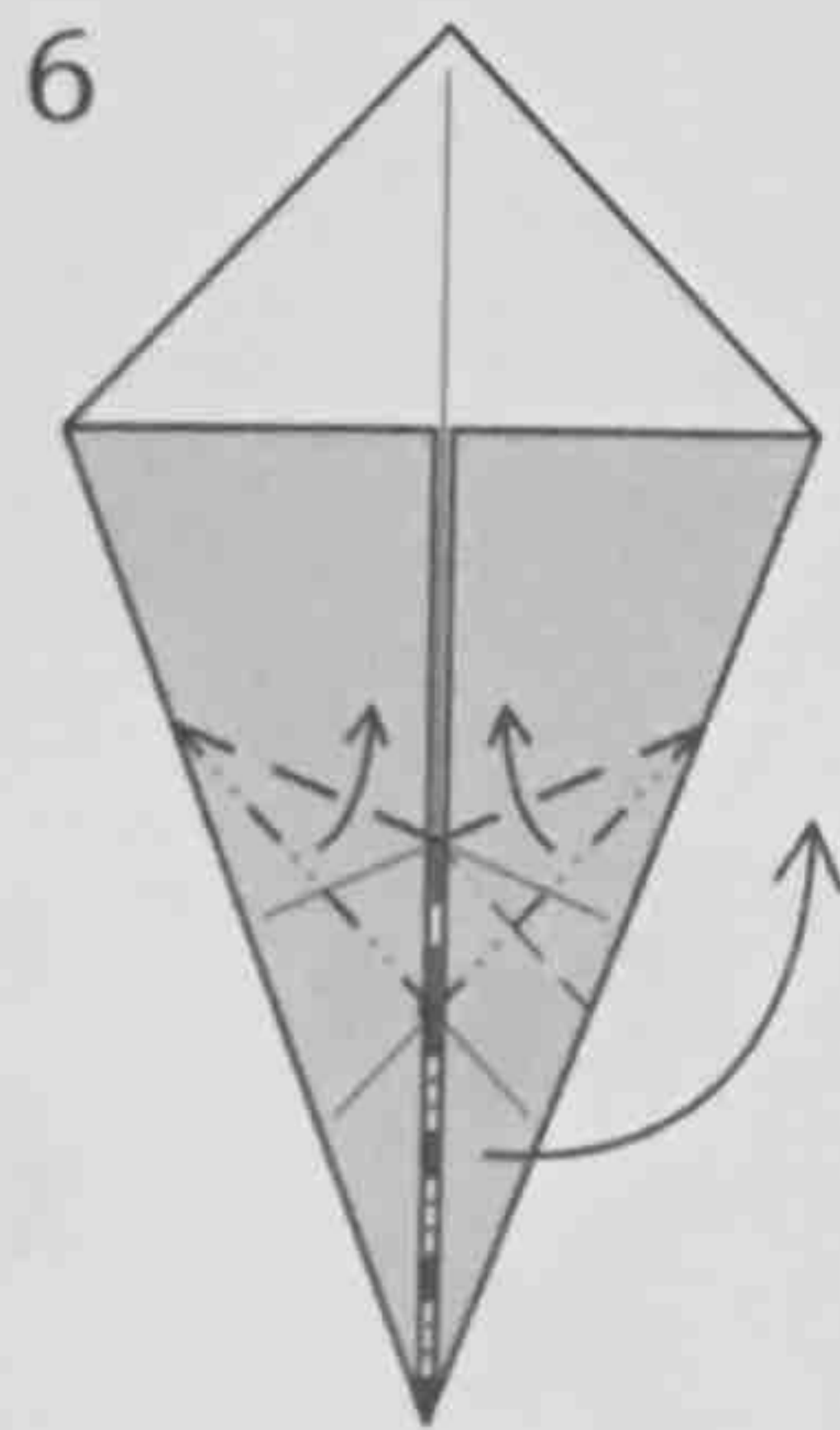

Fold the bottom corner up to the right corner.



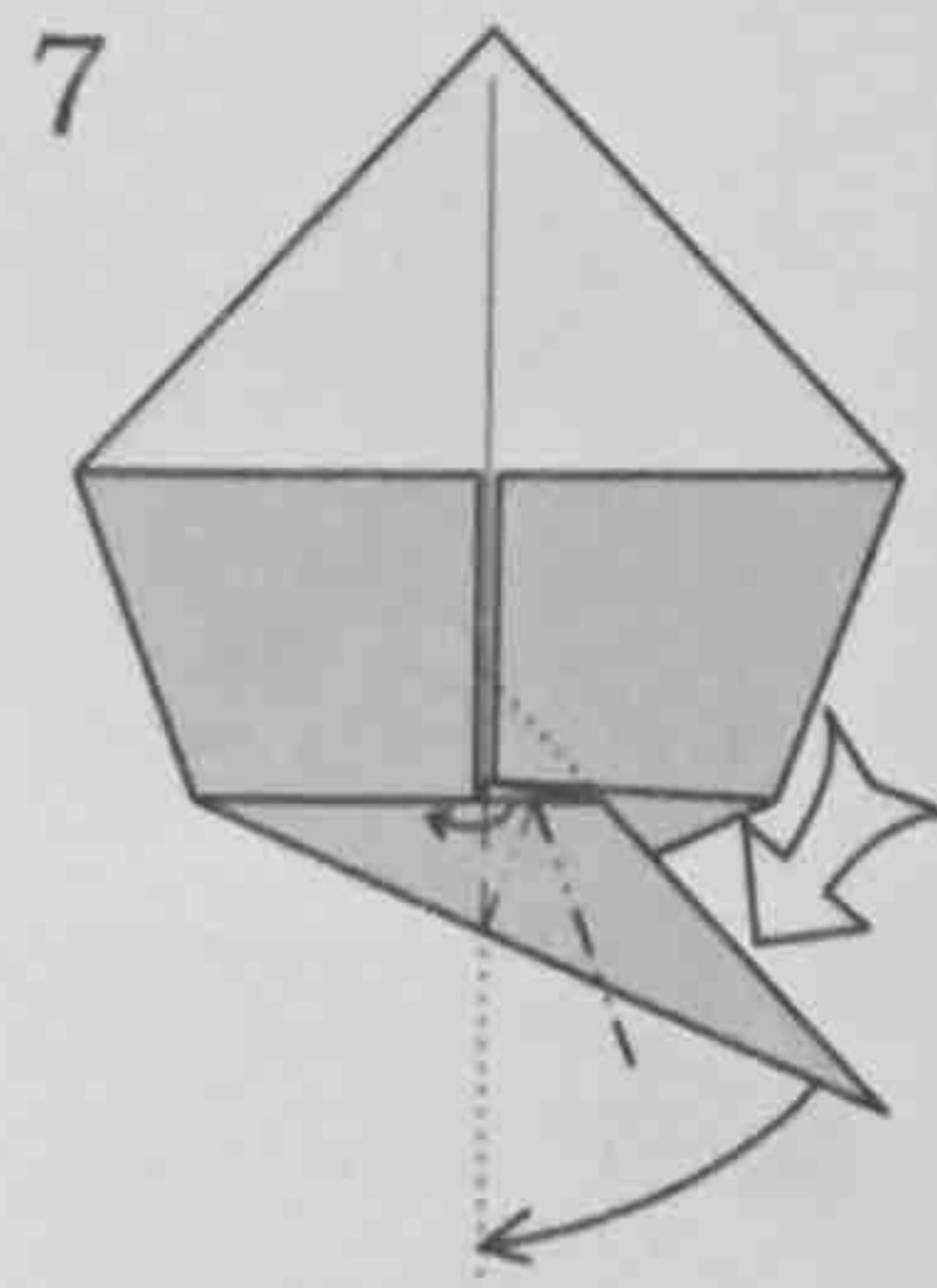

Fold and unfold the flap; then unfold to step 3.



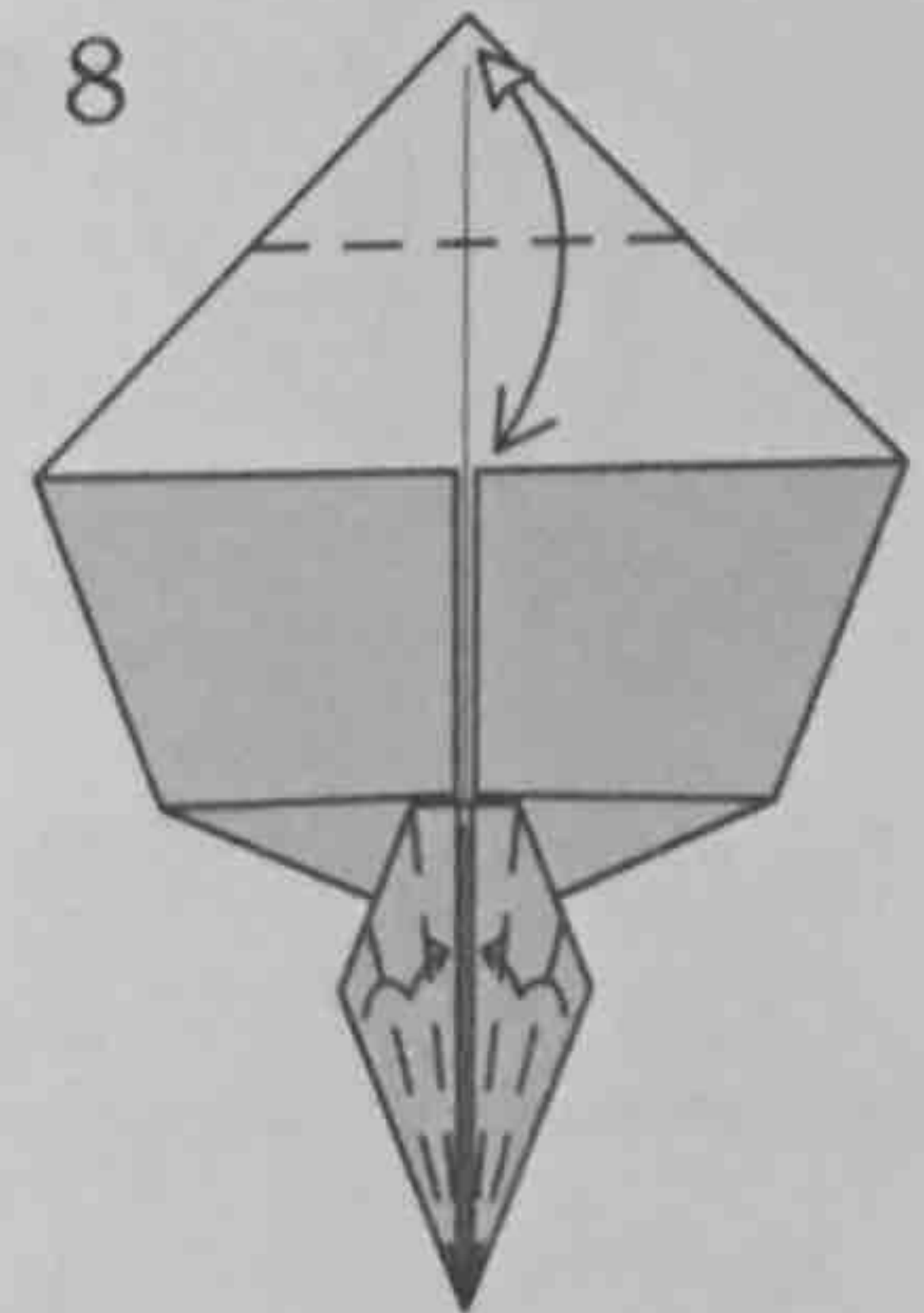

Repeat steps 3-4 on the other side.



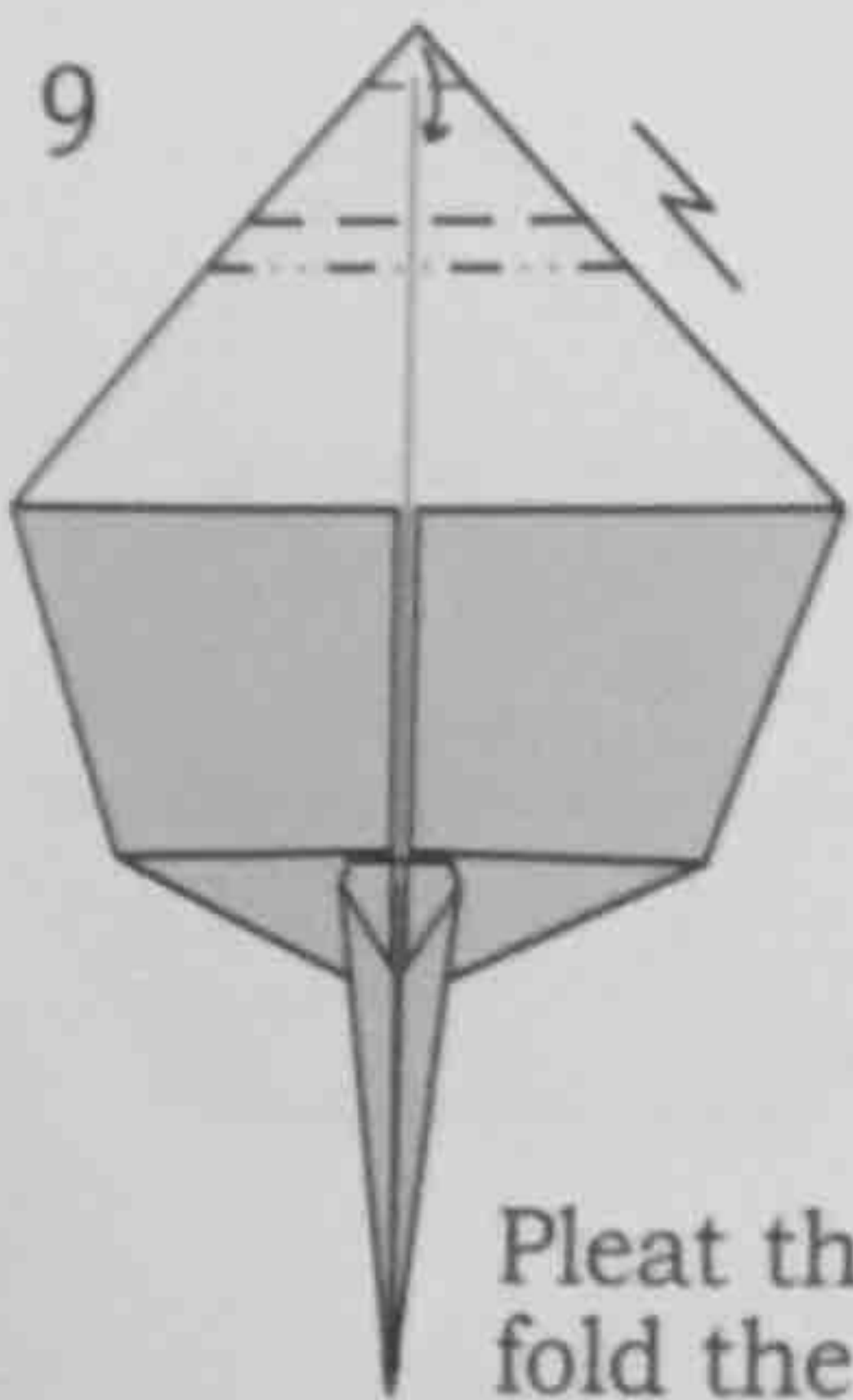

Fold a double rabbit ear on the existing creases.



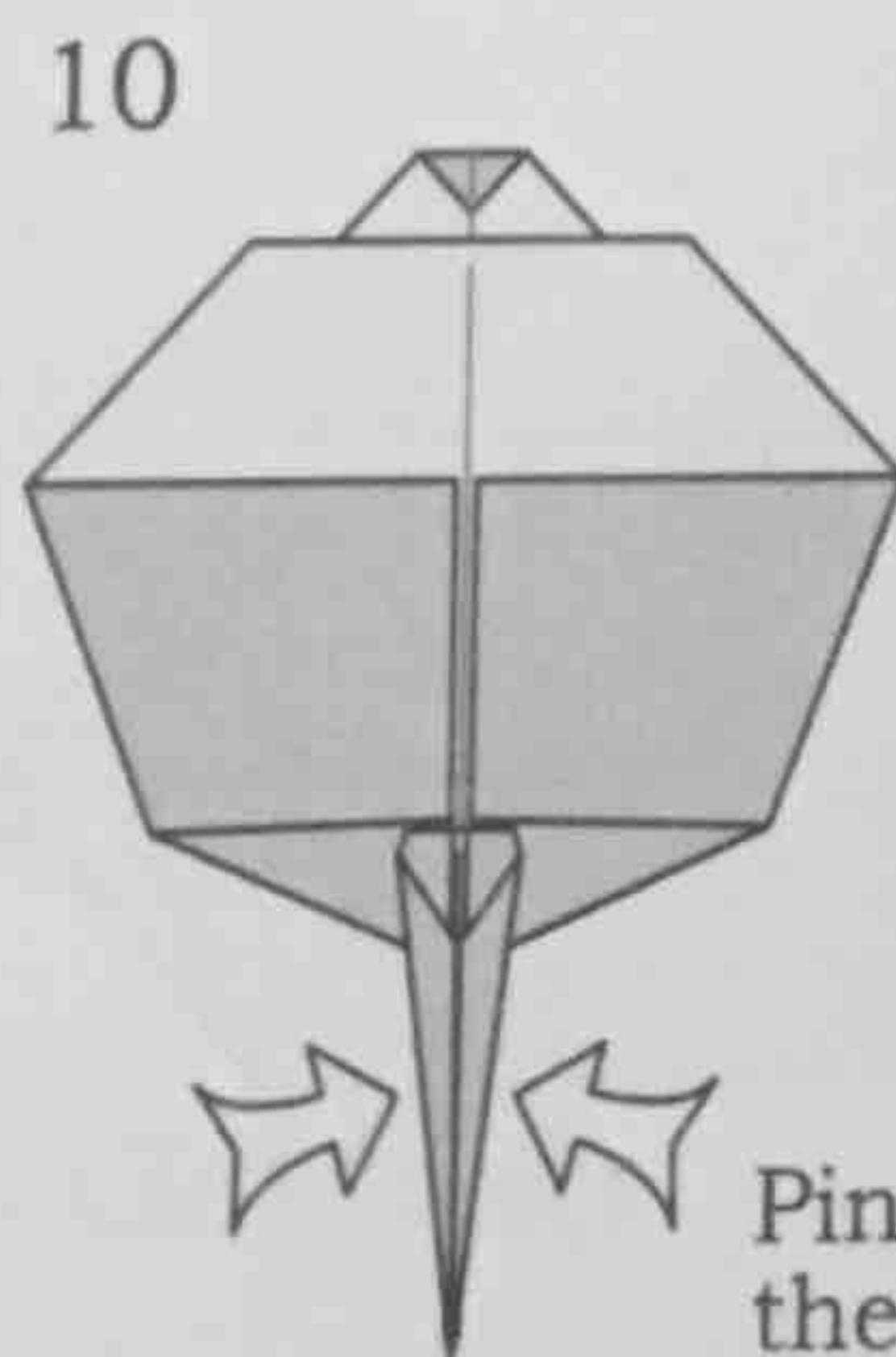

Fold a double rabbit ear on the existing creases.



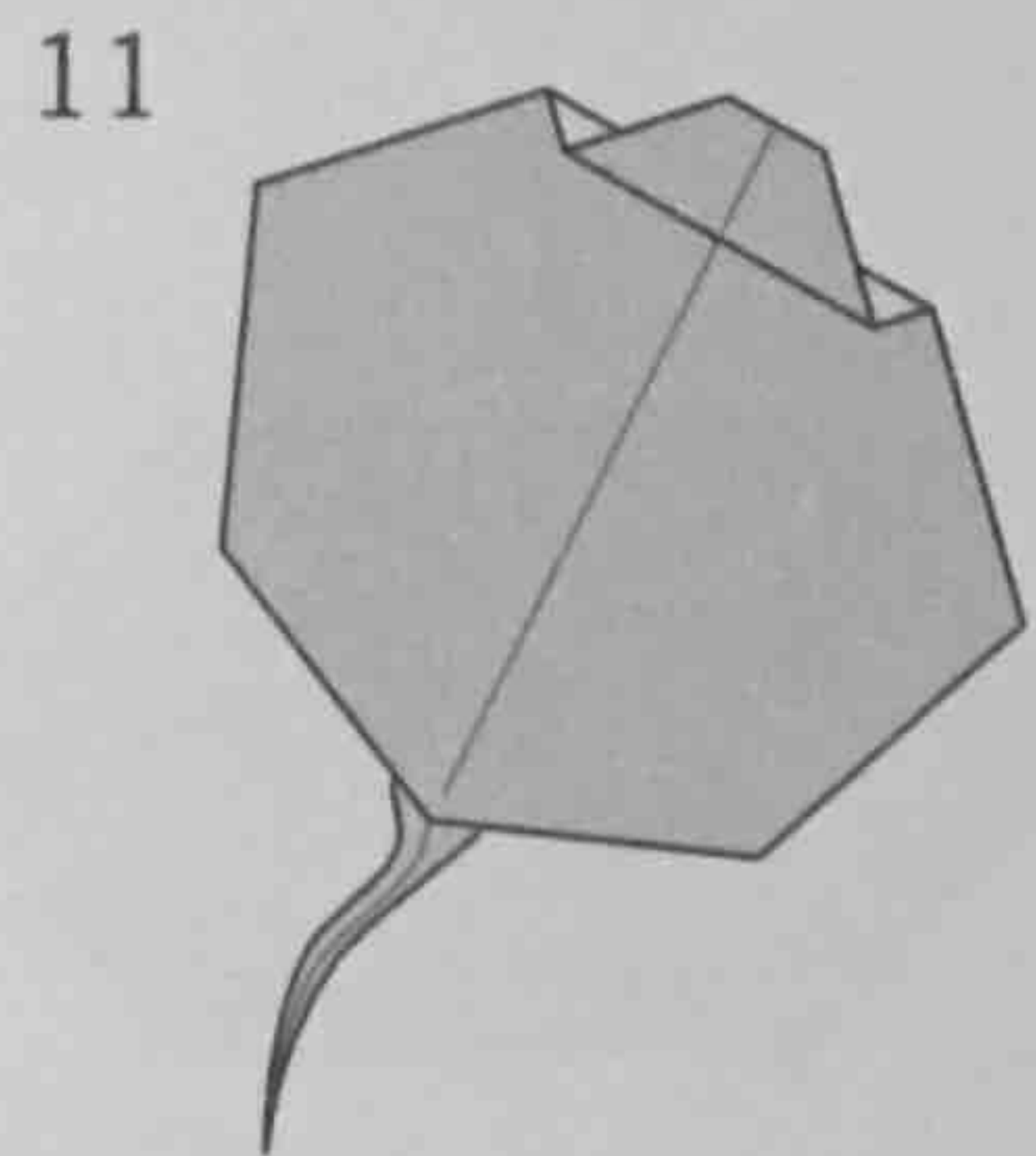
