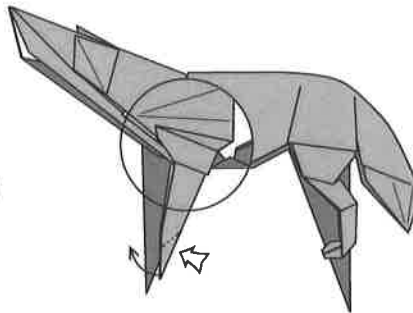
80. This hidden corner is a bit loose. The next series of steps are optional and help lock the corner to the edge behind it.



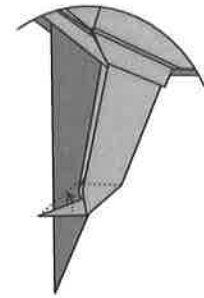
81. Pull out the sunken corner. The paper will not lie flat.



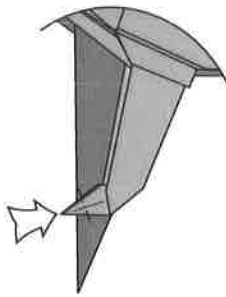
82. Sink back inside to lock. If you prefer you can closed sink the entire region which locks all of the layers together nicely.



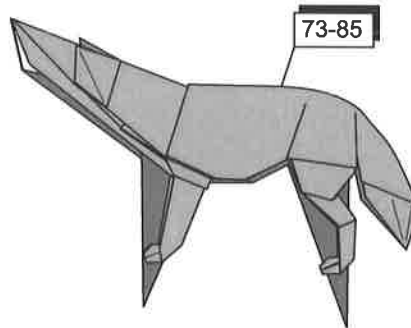
83. Result, now reverse-fold the front paws.



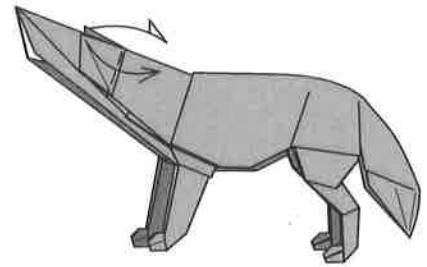
