

Miyama-Karasu-Ageha

Papilio maackii (Papilionidae)

Distribution: Japan, Korean peninsula, Mainland China, Northern Myanmar, etc.

Body size: Approx. 38 to 75 mm

A type of swallowtail butterfly with beautiful wings that have a bluish-green shine. They can often be seen sucking nectar from flowers growing along streams deep in the mountains, or gathering near water.



[Instructions]

Using the picture of the completed insect as a guide, fold along the mountain lines and valley lines to make your own insect.
